The purpose of the INTEGRIS Baptist Medical Center Diagnostic Radiology Medical Student Rotation is to provide a sample of the required core competencies in Patient Care, Medical Knowledge, Practice Based Learning and Improvement, Interpersonal and Communication Skills, Systems Based Practice, and Professionalism while in Diagnostic Radiology.

The Medical Student rotation allows the students to see the specific curriculum to address specific goals and objectives for each subspecialty area of radiology and for each educational level.

- Hours are 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday
- Attendance is mandatory during clinical hours and lectures unless otherwise specified
- Daily conferences are at noon and 4:00 (Occasionally, there is a 7:00am conference)
- You will be required to present an interesting case at one of the resident conferences
- A test will be given at the end of the rotation that will cover some basics of radiology, including anatomy and radiologic findings/diagnosis

Your final grade will be based on the following:

- Test
- Attendance
- Conference presentation
- Clinical grade

Clinical grade will be based on attitude, interest shown, and involvement.
